

YOUR FOODSHARE RIGHTS

You have the right to:

- Apply today and get help applying.
- Get FoodShare benefits (or be notified if you are not able to enroll in the program) within 30 days from when you apply.
- Get FoodShare benefits within seven days if you have little or no money and you qualify for the program.
- Have a fair hearing if you do not agree with any action taken on your case.
