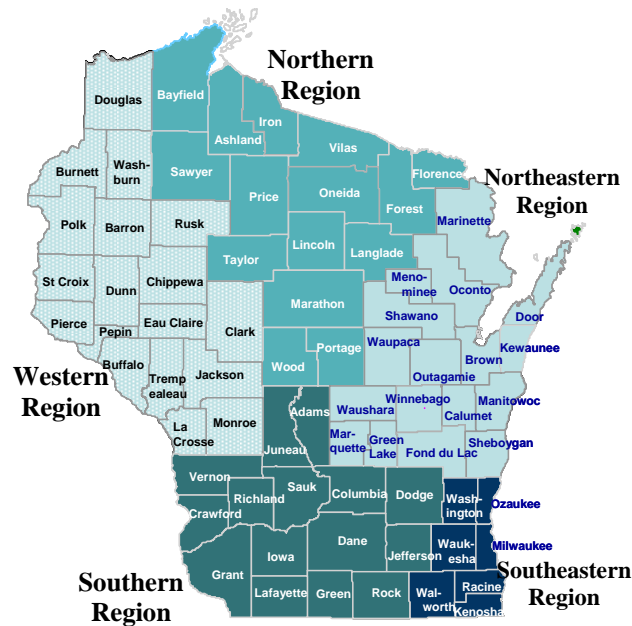
Division of Public Health- Northern Regional Office Mission & Goals
