BadgerCare Plus provides health insurance to:

- Children under age 19
- Pregnant women
- Parents and relatives caring for a child
- Parents with children in foster care
- Young adults leaving out of home care (such as foster care)
- Farmers and other self-employed parents

If you meet one of these and other program rules, you may be able to get BadgerCare Plus.

The sooner you apply, the sooner you can enroll in BadgerCare Plus and have access to health insurance.

All children, regardless of income can get health insurance with BadgerCare Plus.



Major Health Insurance Plans

Standard Plan

If you are one of the following, you may be able to enroll in the Standard Plan. This plan is a full benefit insurance plan for the following groups:

- Pregnant women
- Children
- Parents and relatives caring for a child

It also covers young adults leaving out of home care (such as foster care), regardless of income.

Your family's gross monthly income must be at or under the monthly income limit below:

Family Size	Monthly Income Limit
1	\$1,805.00
2	\$2,428.33
3	\$3,051.67
4	\$3,675.00
5	\$4,298.33
For each additional person, add \$623.33	

Benchmark Plan

If your family income is over the monthly income limit listed above, you may be able to enroll in the Benchmark Plan. This plan is a limited insurance plan for the following people:

- Children
- Pregnant women
- Certain self-employed families



Apply Today!

You should apply even if:

- Your family income is over the monthly income limits because your child may still be able to get health insurance.
- You can get health insurance through your job. In some cases, the state may help pay your premiums, coinsurance and deductibles for employer-sponsored health insurance.
