## **RADON TRAINING, WAUKESHA, NOVEMBER 2009**

Measurement: 8 AM–5 PM Nov. 16 - 17; proficiency exam, 8:00-10:30 AM Nov. 18  
Mitigation: 12:30-5 PM Nov 18; 8 AM -5 PM Nov 19-20; prof. exam 8:00-11:30 AM Nov. 21  
Radon Proficiency CE: Hands-on Mitigation, Tues. Nov. 17, 8 AM to 5 PM  
Radon Control for New Construction, Wed. Nov. 18, 8 AM to 5 PM

Presented by the US EPA regional radon-training center, U. of Minnesota, these courses prepare one for exams and registration (additional paperwork and fee) for proficiency certification by the National Environmental Health Association (NEHA, [www.radongas.org](http://www.radongas.org)) and National Radon Safety Board (NRSB, [www.nrsb.org](http://www.nrsb.org)).

*Measurement training*, including radon science and health risk, is for advising the public and selling measurement services, and is prerequisite for the 2.5-day Mitigation course. Proficiency Continuing Education: In *Hands-on Mitigation*, you're part of a team that installs a radon mitigation system. *Radon Control for New Construction* is about the most cost-effective way to reduce risks from radon: while building new homes.

**Locations:** Nov. 16 - 20: Waukesha Co. Courthouse/Administrative Center, 1320 Pewaukee Road, Waukesha. Pewaukee Rd (Hy J) is exit 294 off of I-94: go two miles south of I-94 to the southwest corner of Pewaukee and Moreland Rds. Many motels are on & near Blue Mounds Road (Hy 18): exit I-94 three miles east of Pewaukee Rd.  
Nov. 21: The mitigation proficiency exam 8 – 11:15 will be at Comfort Suites Lake Country, Thunder Bay Room, N14W24121 Tower Place (off I-94)- Exit #294, Pewaukee, WI 53072 (262) 506-2000

**Fees:** This training is state sponsored at reduced rates for WI residents: Measurement \$395 (WI residents \$195); Mitigation (prerequisite Measurement) \$550 (WI residents \$275); CE 8-hr courses: Rn Control New Homes \$195 (WI resident \$95); Hands-on Mitigation \$250 (WI res. \$125); RPP exams \$150 each. If registering less than 10 days before a class begins, course fees go up by \$50.
