Report My Changes

Report My Changes is a free, easy-to-use tool on the ACCESS web site that lets you report changes to your local county or tribal office. You can report changes online instead of having to call or go to the local agency or by completing a Change Report form. Report My Changes makes it easier to report changes for all programs with one easy-to-use website, and it helps you keep track of the changes you've reported.

You will need to set up a secure account. To set up an account, go to access.wi.gov and follow the instructions on the screen. You will need the following information to create an account:

- Your name.
- Your Social Security Number (SSN) and date of birth. If you do not have an SSN, ask your worker for your Personal Identification Number (PIN).
- Either your Forward card, QUEST card or case number.

Once you have created an account, you can log in any time to report job changes.

How to Use ACCESS in 3 Easy Steps!

① Open a web browser and go to access.wi.gov

② Click on the **Report My Changes** button to report your changes.



Keep in mind that you will only be able to report change for Medicaid, BadgerCare Plus and FoodShare.

③ Follow the instructions on the screen. All of your information will stay private and secure.

You can use ACCESS on any home computer with internet access. You may also be able to use a computer at your local job center, community service agency, church or library.

ACCESS will also help you:

- Apply online for FoodShare, Medicaid, BadgerCare Plus including Family Planning Services.
- Find out which low or no-cost health, nutrition and other programs you might be eligible for.
- Check your Medicaid, BadgerCare Plus, FoodShare, SeniorCare and Caretaker Supplement benefits.
