Am I Eligible?

Am I Eligible? is a free, easy-to-use tool on the ACCESS web site that can help you or someone you know find out which no or low-cost health, nutrition and other programs you might be able to get.

From start to finish, this tool should take about 15 minutes and will tell you if you might be able to get FoodShare, Medicaid, BadgerCare Plus (including Family Planning Services), Caretaker Supplement, SeniorCare and other prescription drug assistance programs, tax credits, other food assistance programs (including meal programs for children) and home energy assistance.

When you use **Am I Eligible?** you will be asked a few basic questions about the people in your home, your money and your bills.

- When you are done, you will get an answer about which programs you might be able to get and how to apply.
- This is just a quick screening tool to see if you might be able to get benefits. You will have to apply for each program to get a final decision about whether or not you will be able to enroll in these programs.

How to Use ACCESS in 3 Easy Steps!

- 1 Open a web browser and go to access.wi.gov
- 2 Click on the **Am I Eligible?** button to see if you may be able to get FoodShare, BadgerCare Plus (including Family Planning Services), Medicaid, SeniorCare and other prescription drug assistance programs, tax credits, other food assistance programs (including free meals for children) and home energy assistance.
- 3 Follow the instructions on the screen. Keep in mind that all of your information will stay private and secure.



You can use ACCESS on any home computer with internet access. You may also be able to use a computer at your local job center, community service agency, church or library.

ACCESS will also help you:

- Apply online for FoodShare, Medicaid, BadgerCare Plus including Family Planning Services.
- Get up-to-date information about the status of your FoodShare, Medicaid, BadgerCare Plus, SeniorCare or Caretaker Supplement benefits.
- Report changes online.
