Dear <recipient name>,

Our records indicate that the labor and delivery cost for the birth of your baby was paid by Wisconsin Medicaid through the Emergency Medicaid program. A recent policy change allows you to get help with health care costs for your baby through Medicaid, if s/he is living with you. Medicaid may pay for services from the date of his/her birth until the end of the month in which s/he reaches one year of age, even if your family's income changes.

If you want your baby enrolled in Medicaid, contact your Medicaid office or complete the bottom portion of this letter and mail or take it to your Medicaid office at the address above.

You will get a Forward card in the mail for your baby. If you have any medical bills, ask your health care provider to send the bill to Wisconsin Medicaid once you get the card. If you have already paid medical bills for covered services, ask your health care provider to send the bills to Wisconsin Medicaid. Ask that those health care providers pay you back for services covered by Medicaid.

Your baby may be able to keep getting Medicaid after s/he turns one year old. To keep getting health care through Medicaid, you will need to complete a review during the month in which your baby turns one year old. Your baby may be able to get Wisconsin Medicaid even if you cannot.
