

YOUR CHILD CARE AND WISCONSIN WORKS (W-2) NOTICES ARE CHANGING!



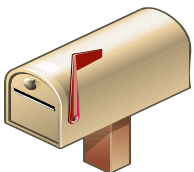
The look of some of the notices that you get from your county or tribal human service agency or W-2 agency about your eligibility for the Child Care or Wisconsin Works (W-2) programs are changing. The goal is to make the Notices of Eligibility easier to understand. The information in the new Notice of Eligibility about your case is similar to the old Notice of Eligibility, but the new notice is organized differently, has more detail and will be easier to understand.

The new Notice of Eligibility will give you:

- An easy-to-read summary page as the first page.
- Details about eligibility decisions.
- For financial eligibility decisions, information on income and assets you reported to your worker and how that information was used to make your eligibility decision.
- More ways to contact your worker.
- Information on what to do if you disagree with the decision and the date you have to do it by.

You may get both Child Care and W-2 notices in one envelope. If you get benefits from the FoodShare or Medicaid programs, you will get notices about those programs in a separate envelope.
