We are writing to let you know that the rules for getting FoodShare benefits have changed. **As of March 1, 2008, you no longer have to take part in the FoodShare Employment and Training (FSET) program in order to get FoodShare benefits.** This rule change is part of Wisconsin's 2007-2009 State Budget.

Keep in mind that the FSET program is not ending and FSET services are still available to you . If you would like to volunteer for FSET, you should keep going to your FSET activities. You should also let your FSET worker know that you want to volunteer for the program.

Keep in mind that if FSET is helping to pay for your child care or transportation, you will need to complete your FSET activities in order to keep getting these services. If you stop going to your FSET activities, you will not be able to get help with child care and transportation from the FSET program
