Question:* Section 2.3.3.3 asks the proposer to provide evidence that the proposer has a workable plan and the resources to, by the time the contract is entered into build a comprehensive network of providers with the capacity to deliver the proposed managed long-term care benefit specified in Section 2.2.3. Would an agency need to submit its provider network listing as evidence?

Answer: No, there is no need to submit a provider network listing with the RFP. However, in your response, you do need to address all the bullet points listed in that RFP section. Organizations that receive a letter of intent to contract will be required to submit a provider network listing during the certification process.
