This letter is notification that the Department of Health Services (DHS) intends to contract with Community Care, Inc., and Community Care Health Plan, Inc., to offer the Family Care and Family Care Partnership benefits in Milwaukee County, contingent upon successful completion of the certification process.

The Department received four proposals in response to RFP 1645-DDES-SM. In addition to Community Care, Inc., the Department is sending letters of intent to contract contingent upon successful completion of the certification process to the Milwaukee County Department on Aging, Care Management Organization (MCDA-CMO) for Family Care. In addition to Community Care Health Plan, Inc., the Department is sending a letter to I-Care informing them that they may move to the certification process for Family Care Partnership upon provision of assurances to the Department that they intend to meet the Family Care Partnership contractual requirements for consumer representation on its governing board. The Department is informing Managed Health Services (MHS) that its proposal was not accepted.

A total of 5,745 points was available to each proposer. Below is a summary of the actual RFP scoring.
