Registration is limited to 50 people.

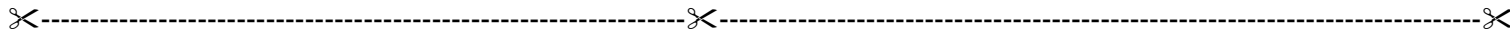
Confirmations: Will be sent via e-mail. If you do not provide an e-mail address, you will not receive a confirmation.

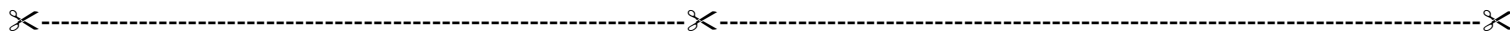

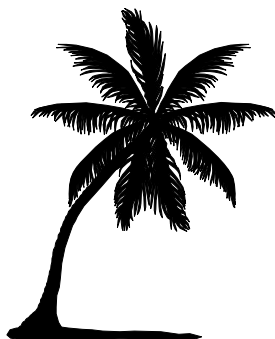

Program Content

OASIS (Outcome and Assessment Information Set) is a federally required data set for Medicare-certified home health agencies. This program is designed for home health agency staff who are directly involved with the transmission of OASIS records to the State OASIS System. The State OASIS System enables agencies to transmit OASIS records, receive feedback reports, and to generate other OASIS related reports.

Program Goals

This program will provide participants with information about the OASIS automation process and transmission requirements. After attending this workshop participants will be able to:

- Define federal OASIS automation requirements;
- Use the State OASIS System to correctly transmit OASIS records to the State database;
- Use validation reports to verify that records have been accepted by the State OASIS System;
- Use the validation report messages and descriptions to identify and correct problems related to the transmission of OASIS records;
- Use State OASIS System to access CASPER (Certification and Survey Provider Enhanced Reports) reports to evaluate the agency's OASIS automation activity;
- Use the OASIS electronic correction policy to ensure data accuracy; and
- Use the State OASIS System to retrieve OBQM (Outcome Based Quality Monitoring) and OBQI (Outcome Based Quality Improvement) reports using CASPER.

Intended Audience

The intended audience includes:

- New home health agency staff,
- Home health agency staff who have responsibility for transmission of OASIS data to the State OASIS System or access the system to obtain OBQM and OBQI reports,
- Home health agency staff who wish to review the basic OASIS reporting regulations, and
- Other health professionals who have an interest in OASIS automation.

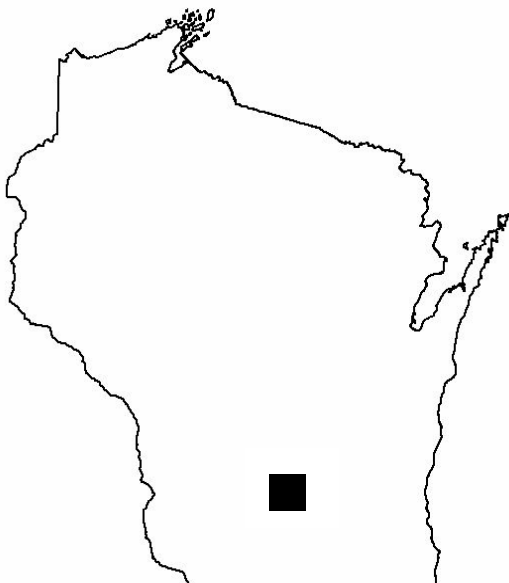
