

## Instructions to Download *AbstractPlus*, Version 2.4.0

The latest version of *AbstractPlus*, Version 2.4.0, data entry software is now available from WCRS. The software, along with the accompanying *AbstractPlus* user manual, CRS Main Line data submission software and CRS Main Line manual, are available for download from the following FTP site:

You will need a userID and password to access the above FTP site. Please use the following:

This version of *AbstractPlus* should be downloaded by facilities not yet using the program and also by facilities that are using the program but have an earlier version. The manual includes instructions on how to install the program for different situations (update vs. new install).

If you already have CRS Main Line installed, it is not necessary to download those two files as no updates were made.
