Options used a 3D printer to create low-cost assistive technology devices for HCBS Members.

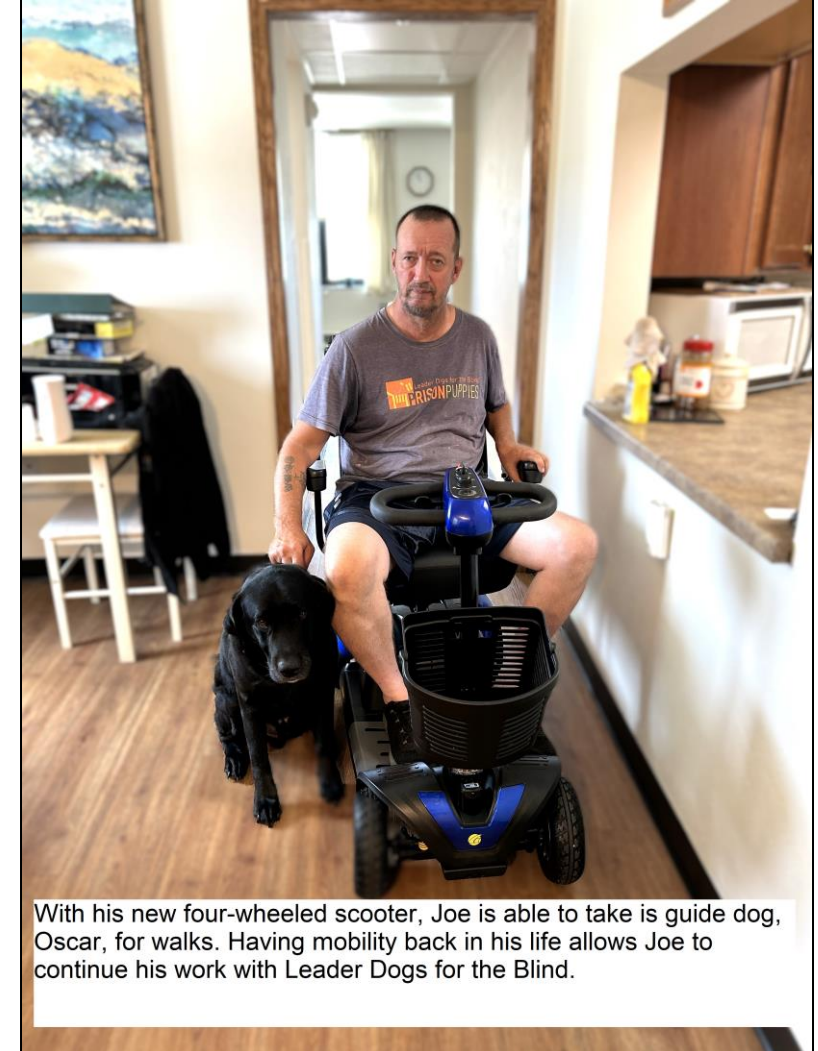
Options for Independent Living
