We asked attendees about their time at the summit, and if we met our goal to **innovate**, **collaborate**, **and communicate**.




ON A SCALE OF 1 TO 5, WHAT DID YOU THINK OF THE SUMMIT?

"Speaking to others on innovation and their utilization of grant awards was invaluable." "The schedule was diverse and had a good mix of listening, participation, and learning. Great job!"


Attendees answered a series of questions on how useful the summit was for their everyday work.


The summit was relevant to my work.
