

## **Pre-6 Pandemic EBT for Young Children**

You are getting this letter because you have a young child or children who may usually get free or reduced price meals through a childcare facility but may not have gotten them at times since October 2020 because of the pandemic.

Last year, the federal government created the Pandemic EBT (P-EBT) program to support families of school-age children who were learning from home full time or part time because of the COVID-19 pandemic. Because many childcare facilities also closed or operated with reduced in-person attendance, the federal government has now created a version of P-EBT (Pre-6 P-EBT) to support families of younger children under the age of 6 who are <u>not</u> in school.

This letter tells you if your young child or children are getting Pre-6 P-EBT benefits for the months of Month YYYY through Month YYYY and, if so, how much you will get. You will get another letter in the future about benefits for other months after Month YYYY.

Pre-6 P-EBT benefits are based on how often students in schools in your area of the state were reported to be learning from home each month. Pre-6 P-EBT allows states to provide a maximum of \$6.82 per weekday that each eligible child was at home and did not get meals at a childcare facility. Due to Federal program requirements, children are only eligible for this benefit for months when their family received FoodShare benefits. The following child or children in your family are not getting Pre-6 P-EBT benefits at this time.
