Unfunded High-Need Communities

Description of Variables:

- Population Size: Based on 2016 Wisconsin Interactive Statistics on Health estimates.
- Tribal Nation Area: Indicates if a tribe resides in the area of the county boundaries.
- Death Rate: Calculated based on average deaths over 2016-2017 and population size.
- Total Deaths: Total count of deaths in the county for 2016-2017.
- Hospitalization Rate: Calculated based on average hospitalizations over 2016-2017 and population size.
- Rate of Opioid Use Disorder in Medicaid Population: Calculated rate of those with an opioid use disorder diagnosis out of all those served in the Medicaid population from 2016-2017.
- County-Authorized Persons: Calculated from the Program Participation System describing the number of consumers with an opioid-related substance problem receiving substance use treatment services in 2016 and 2017.

Total hospitalization counts are not included in the table.
