VI. Review and Discuss Current GCPD Bylaws

- Following sections of the bylaws were reviewed and recommendations is noted:
- Article III, Membership, Section 1, Committee Composition Paragraph A
 Original A majority of Governor's Committee members (66%) shall be people with disabilities.
 - **Revised** A simple majority, defined as 51% of Governor's Committee members **shall** be people with disabilities. The Committee shall strive to have the greatest possible representation by people with disabilities on the committee.
- Article III, Membership, Section 2, Term of Service Paragraph B
 Added new At-Large Members appointed shall serve an initial term of 4 (four) years, with a re-appointment to a second term of 4 (four) years. At the end of 8 years of service, Members may reapply for potential re-

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appointment.

- Article III, Membership, Section 2, Term of Service Paragraph C
 Added new It is preferred that potential appointees experience disability, have a record of disability, and/or are regarded as having a disability.
- Article III, Membership, Section 2, Term of Service Paragraph D
 Original Paragraph B was moved to Paragraph D
- Article III, Membership, Section 3, Voting Authority Paragraph E
 Added new Virtual, or accessible electronic means of voting shall be accepted in lieu of in-person votes.
- Article III, Membership, Section 4, Resignation and Removal -Paragraph A

Original -it will be assumed that the resignation will be effective as of the date the letter is received by the Governor's Office. The Governor's Committee requests that a copy of the letter also be sent to the Governor's Committee Chairperson.

Revised - it will be assumed that the resignation will be effective as of the date the Governor's Office and Chair receives the letter. The Governor's Committee requests that a copy of the letter also be sent to Department of Health Services (DHS) staff member.

 Time allocated for meeting was met. At next meeting the committee will pick at - Article III, Membership, Section 4, Resignation and Removal - Paragraph B. See Action Item 1.
