V. Public Comment on Issues Affecting People with Disabilities

- Lawrence Brown (Community Member) made public comment regarding the concerns on the availability of broadband internet in country and rural areas. Also, stated concerns about access to non-emergency medical transportation and concerns with quality transportation in the Milwaukee and Madison.
- Daniel Idzikowski (GCPD Member-at-Large) commented that he would like to make it known to the Executive Committee that there are movements behind closed doors to privatize the Family Care Long-term Care system and there are concerns about this and ongoing services if the system does become privatized.

VI. Discuss Feedback from the August 17, 2022, GCPD Bi-Monthly Meeting

VIII. Discuss Department of Health Services (DHS) General Updates

- Karen Odegaard, DHS Office of the Secretary, shared updates regarding the following:
 - DHS is preparing to submit our proposed 2023-25 Budget. The State of Wisconsin's budget covers a 2-year period (July 1, 2023-June 30, 2025).
 - DHS is preparing for an end to temporary federal Medicaid policies put in place during the COVID-19 pandemic.
 - Anyone who has been a member of BadgerCare Plus or Medicaid since March 2020 still has health care coverage through BadgerCare Plus or Wisconsin Medicaid programs (Family Care, IRIS, or Children's Long-Term Support).
 People should be using their coverage and not delaying care.
 - To receive up-to-date information on policy changes, members should update their contact information either on the ACCESS website (access.wi.gov), or the MyACCESS smartphone app, or by calling their local agency.



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- Amber Mullett, Director, Office for the Promotion of Independent Living shared some General DHS updates:

 - The Independent Living Support Piolet is an opportunity to pilot the expansion of enhanced benefits to help people who do not qualify for publicly funded LTC to remain in their homes. ADRCs and tribal ADRS agencies will be invited to apply for the opportunity to administer a new pilot program, which will start in 2023. The pilot program will be available to people who have a need for help with one or more activities of daily living and are not yet functionally or financially eligible for publicly funded long-term care programs. Program participants will be provided with flexible funding (approx. \$7,200 per person) to purchase items and services that help them continue living independently in their homes. This project is supported by enhanced federal Medicaid matching funds for Home and Community Based Services under the American Rescue Plan Act.
