- VI. Discuss Opportunities and Access Section of the GCPD 2022-2024 Work
 Plan
 - Discuss the Recommendation for Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Coordinator Position within Government
 - The Sub-Committee discussed legislative and state budget strategies for getting an ADA position to address digital and physical accessibility to state government websites, buildings, programs, and services.



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- The Sub-Committee discussed an ADA compliance position within state government. Discussion was had about these positions existed in other states, are often appointed positions, and housed within the state Department of Administration or Department of Justice.
- Ben Barret will share the policy recommendation from the Opportunities and Access Sub-Committee of creating a state ADA compliance position at GCPD's Executive Committee meeting on March 2, 2023. See Action Item 1.
- The Sub-Committee discussed the possibility of working with other disability coalitions, committees, and councils to advocate for these positions.
- Discuss and Review Status of Disability Related Civil Rights
 Complaints Routing Through Wisconsin Attorney General
 - Lisa Sobczyk and Margaret Kristan, GCPD Chair met with the Attorney General's office on January 19, 2023, to learn about the history of LRB-2121/1, whether the Attorney General planned to reintroduce the bill, and discuss the impact it could have for people with disabilities.
 - Based on the meeting with the Attorney General's Office racial inequities was the reason for the bill being introduced. However, there is a benefit to explaining the benefits to people with disabilities.
 - The Department of Justice will follow-up with the Attorney General's Office to see if they plan to reintroduce the bill. If the bill is reintroduced, the Department of Justice will work with GCPD on education and outreach on how the bill would benefit people with disabilities.



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VII. Discuss Aging Advocacy and Assistive Technology (AT) Act Funding Initiative

- The Sub-Committee discussed recently passed federal legislation which would require the State Assistive Technology Program to work with Older Americans Act programs. The Sub-Committee discussed how that may allow more older adults to gain access to assistive technology.
- Lisa Sobczyk shared with the Sub-Committee that the Assistive Technology Act was reauthorized in January 2023 and expanded required membership on the State Assistive Technology Advisory Council and focuses more on document and digital accessibility. As a result, there may be opportunities to partner with the State Assistive Technology Council in advancing some of the policy recommendations being proposed by GCPD's Opportunities and Access Sub-Committee.
 - Lisa Sobczyk will ask Laura Plummer to present on the Reauthorization of the Assistive Technology Act at the March Opportunities and Access Sub-Committee meeting. See Action Item 2.
