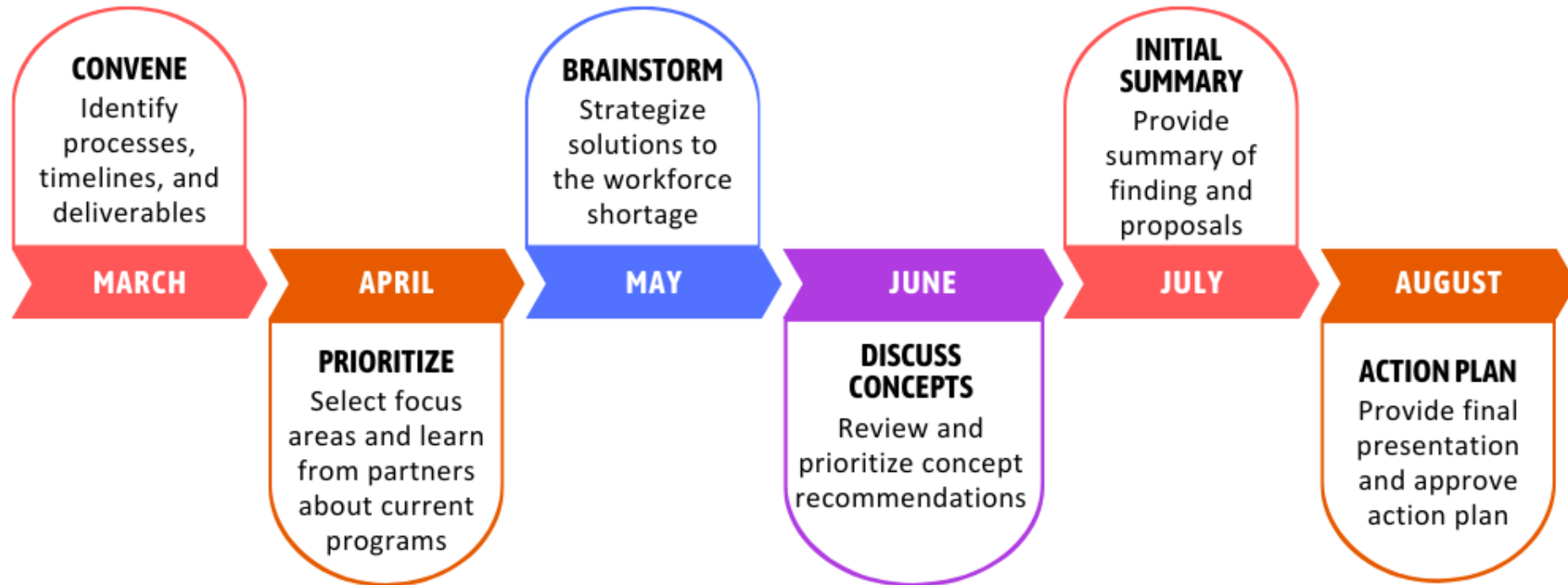
Task Force Progress



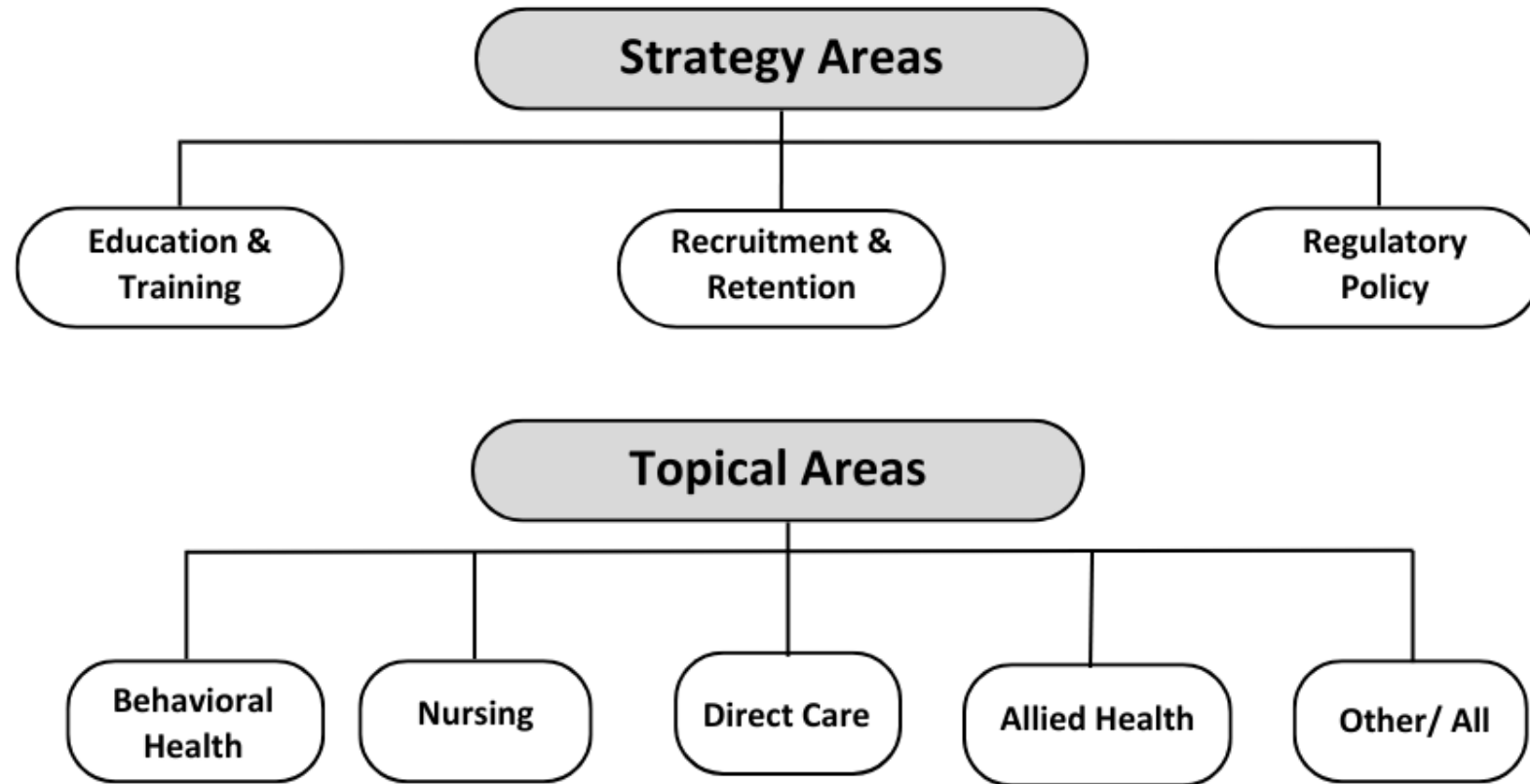
Executive Order

- The Task Force shall gather and analyze information and produce an advisory **action plan** for the Governor.
- The Task Force shall provide its action plan for 2025-27 biennial budget consideration no later than **September 1, 2024**, and shall disband after the plan is submitted.

Survey Results

Category 1: Incorporated

- Changes made in final report
- In scope
- Discussion with task force not necessary

Category 2: Implementation

- Related to program design and/or implementation
- Level of detail exceeds report
- Shared with Governor's Office (GO) and State Budget Office (SBO) for consideration

Category 3: Out of Scope

- New ideas
- Limited time to discuss with task force
- Shared with GO/SBO
- Bring to future conversations for consideration

Category 4: Comment Only

Final Recommendations

- **10** recommendations and **26** action items
- Categories:
 - Education and training (4 recommendations, 12 action items)
 - Recruitment and retention (3 recommendations, 7 action items)
 - Regulatory policy (3 recommendations, 7 action items)

Recommendations: Education and Training

- Support health professions faculty
- Strengthen clinical training and experience
- Reduce barriers to training
- Expand apprenticeships and other learning opportunities

Recommendations: Recruitment and Retention

- Increase payer support for recruitment and retention
- Foster recruitment and retention in areas of need
- Support regional innovation

Recommendations: Regulatory Policy

- Support expanded pathways to licensure
- Strengthen state capacity to support licensure
- Strengthen workforce monitoring and support

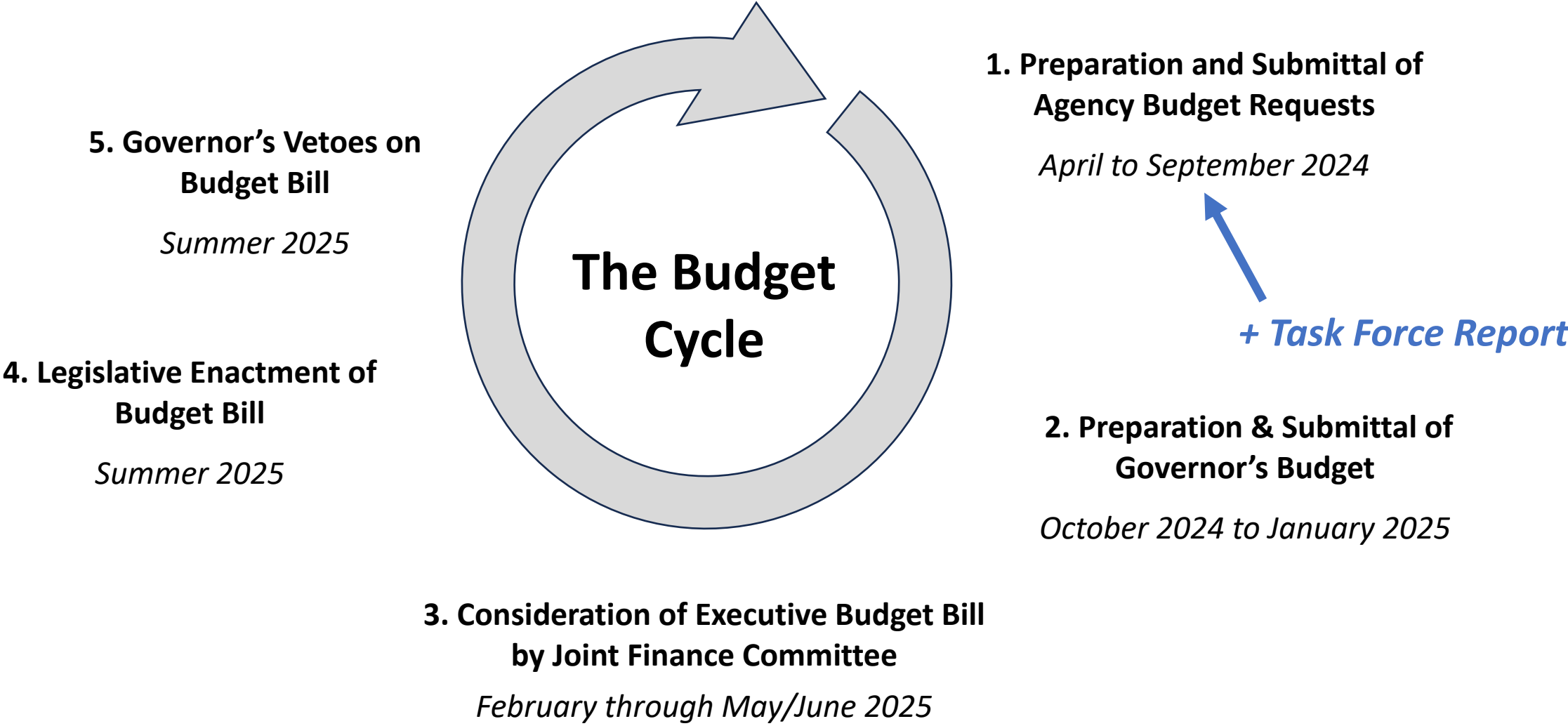


Next steps

Next Steps

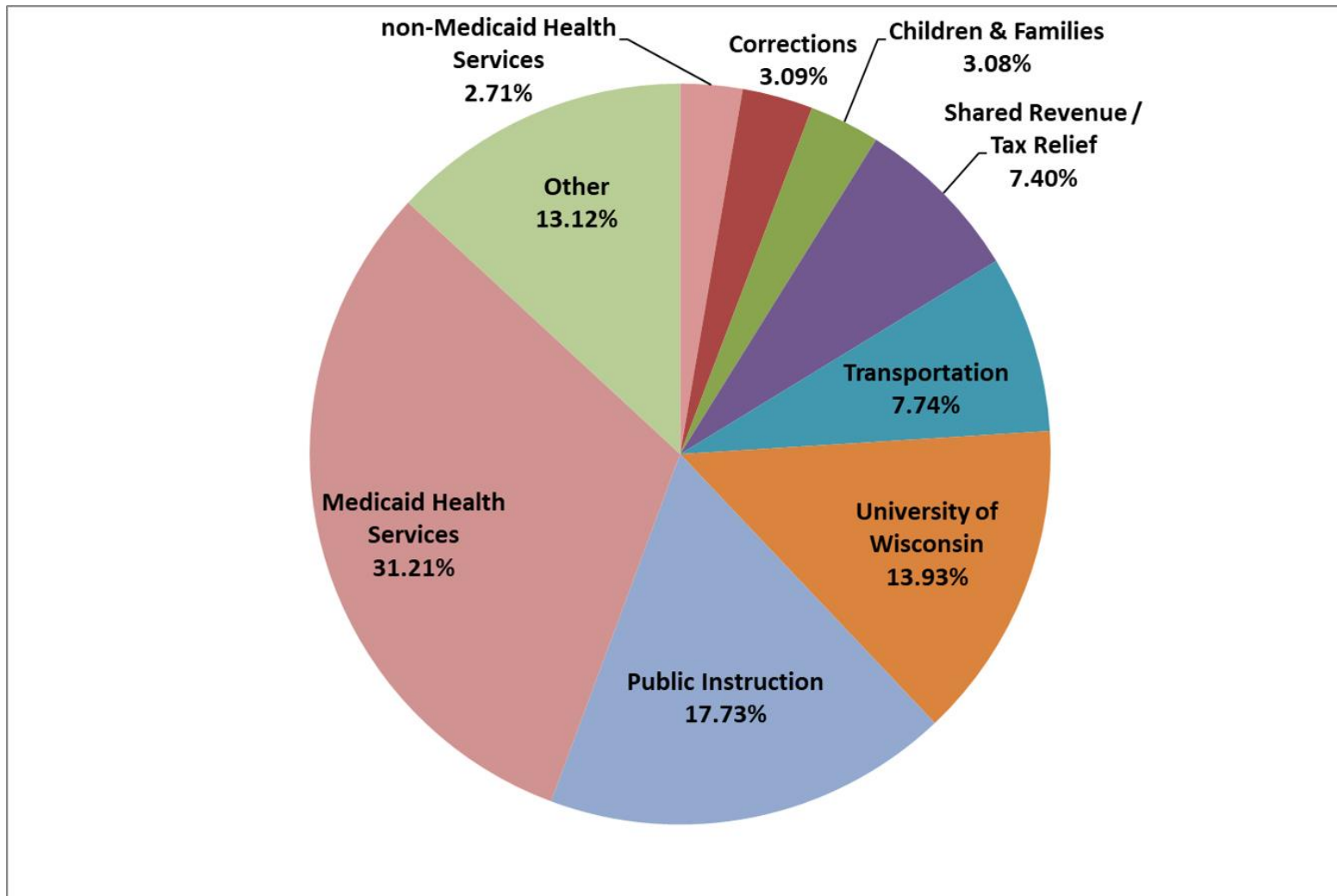
- Chair and Co-Vice Chairs help finalize and publish the report
