

## Overview

The Document Viewer in CWW provides Income Maintenance (IM), Childcare (CC), FSET (Food Share Employment and Training), and Wisconsin Works (W-2) agency workers with the ability to view and edit documents received from applicants and members.

The existing Document Viewer is built on Java Applet technology, which has several known security vulnerabilities and is incompatible with modern web browsers, including Chrome, and Microsoft Edge, creating a risk to the business community of doc viewer.

The CWW Document Viewer Replacement Project aims to replace the custom coded Java applet-based CWW document viewer with Commercial off-the-shelf product-ImageTrust based document view solution, maintaining most of the existing functions to create a seamless transition for users.

# **Key Functions**

The goal is to seamlessly integrate the ImageTrust software into the CWW Document Viewer and provide all existing functions that all workers currently use.



#### **Read Only Functions**

- Thumbnails View
- Zoom
- Pan
- Page Navigation within a Document
- Page Navigation between Documents
- Rotate (without saving)



### **Manipulation Functions**

- Rotate with Save
- Merge Documents
- Rearrange Pages
- Discard Pages
- Split Page (Vertically or Horizontally)
- Split Document (to one or more documents)
- Stamp document (Annotate) with Received date and Agency

- Index/Re-index Document
- Assigning and Processing Documents
- Deleting Documents
- Comments
- Image Manipulation Audit History
- Document Metadata Viewer

# ImageTrust Upgrade

Once ImageTrust Upgrade project is complete, Document Viewer's associated pages within CWW will not have any dependency on the applet and Internet Explorer. The next subsequent project in the pipeline and just after the ImageTrust deployment is to make rest of CWW pages compatible with Chrome and Edge browser types which will then remediate CWW completely from IE browser Dependency.
