Approval of October 17, 2024, Meeting Minutes (Katie Sepnieski)

 Motions made to approve the minutes by Steve Budnik and Adam Chorlton, then approved by consensus.

Policy Updates (Department of Health Services)

Healthcare

Medicaid Purchase Plan (MAPP)

- The Department continues working to address systems and process challenges related to the reinstatement of MAPP premiums.
- Terminations of MAPP coverage for members that do not pay their premium on time remain paused. During this temporary pause, MAPP members are still expected to pay premiums, but will not lose coverage because of not paying their premium.
- The Department remains committed to letting income maintenance and other interested partners know at least a month in advance of resuming premium-related disensollments.

Operations Memos

- The Department recently published three health care operations memos:
 - Operations Memo 24-29 removing the policy to count cash benefits a person may be entitled to but not receiving effective January 1, 2025, was published on November 7th,
 - Operations Memo 24-31 announcing ten new class of admission codes for immigrants was published on November 12th, and
 - Operations Memo 24-32 for the Private Pay Nursing Home and Group B Plus Waiver Rates was published on November 18th.
- Additional annual health care operations memos that will be published include:
 - The Cost-of-Living Adjustment (COLA) for Medicaid for the Elderly, Blind, or Disabled, which announces this year's Social Security COLA and the resulting increase in some Medicaid financial eligibility limits for 2025.
 - The Annual Update to Income Thresholds for Determining Whether a Child or Tax
 Dependent is Expected to be Required to File a Tax Return.
- The mass change for the COLA and rate changes will occur on December 7, 2024.

Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) Recipients Eligibility for Marketplace Plans

- Eligibility for Marketplace coverage was extended to DACA, and certain other noncitizens, including:
 - o Individuals granted Special Immigrant Juvenile status,
 - o Children under the age of 14 applying for asylum or humanitarian relief, and
 - Individuals with pending applications for adjustment of status.
- The federal rule did not change the members eligibility for BadgerCare Plus or Medicaid. It created a way for members to obtain health care coverage with tax credits on the Marketplace as early as December.
