For Providers:

• Health care providers should use trauma informed language when medical charting. (1)

For Facilities:

• Health care facilities should build connections with social support services, such as Aging and Disability Resource Centers, so that providers can connect patients with appropriate social support when needed. (1)

For Systems:

- Payors should support pharmacies and providers to use reminder systems, medication delivery, and other technology to support those with complex medical conditions or high needs. (1)
- Health systems should have early warnings systems for patients with existing cardiac disease to expedite management and treatment from the emergency department. (1)
- Payers should utilize community-based postpartum visits with community health workers
 or doulas to address key postpartum screenings and other issues, including mental
 health, social support, and isolation, particularly for medically complex patients. (1)
- Counties should provide care coordinators or advocates to help clients understand complex medical conditions and medication management especially when they are pregnant or postpartum. (1)
- Payors should cover community and home based care for those with mental health conditions that struggle entering the health care system or where resources are scarce. (1)
