- Approximately 130 nursing homes
- 50 cohort collaboration with their local middle school or high school
- Evaluation will focus on the impact of the intergenerational aspects of the project.

Phase II Six-Month Survey - August 2015





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


Six-month Implementation Survey



Rate where you are in the Wisconsin Music & Memory implementation




Approximately how many songs do you have in your iTunes library?






Of the 10 residents, how many have shown improvement and are now calmer, more relaxed, less anxious, more engaged or happier?



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Of the 10 residents how many who were prescribed anti-psychotic or anti-anxiety medications stopped or decreased since implementation?



Of the 10 residents how many who were using bed/chair alarms, have stopped or decreased since implementation?



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Enter the number of new residents added beyond the original 10. (Total 243)




How have you expanded your program? (78 Responses)






What media contacts have you made to promote your program? (48 Responses)






If you contacted media, and received coverage, how effective was it in raising awareness about your facility and Program?






Rate the overall effectiveness of the Program for the participating residents.






Rate the overall effectiveness of the Program for the participating families/friends.




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Rate the overall effectiveness of the Program for the facility staff.




Have you participated in the monthly support webinars hosted by DHS staff?
