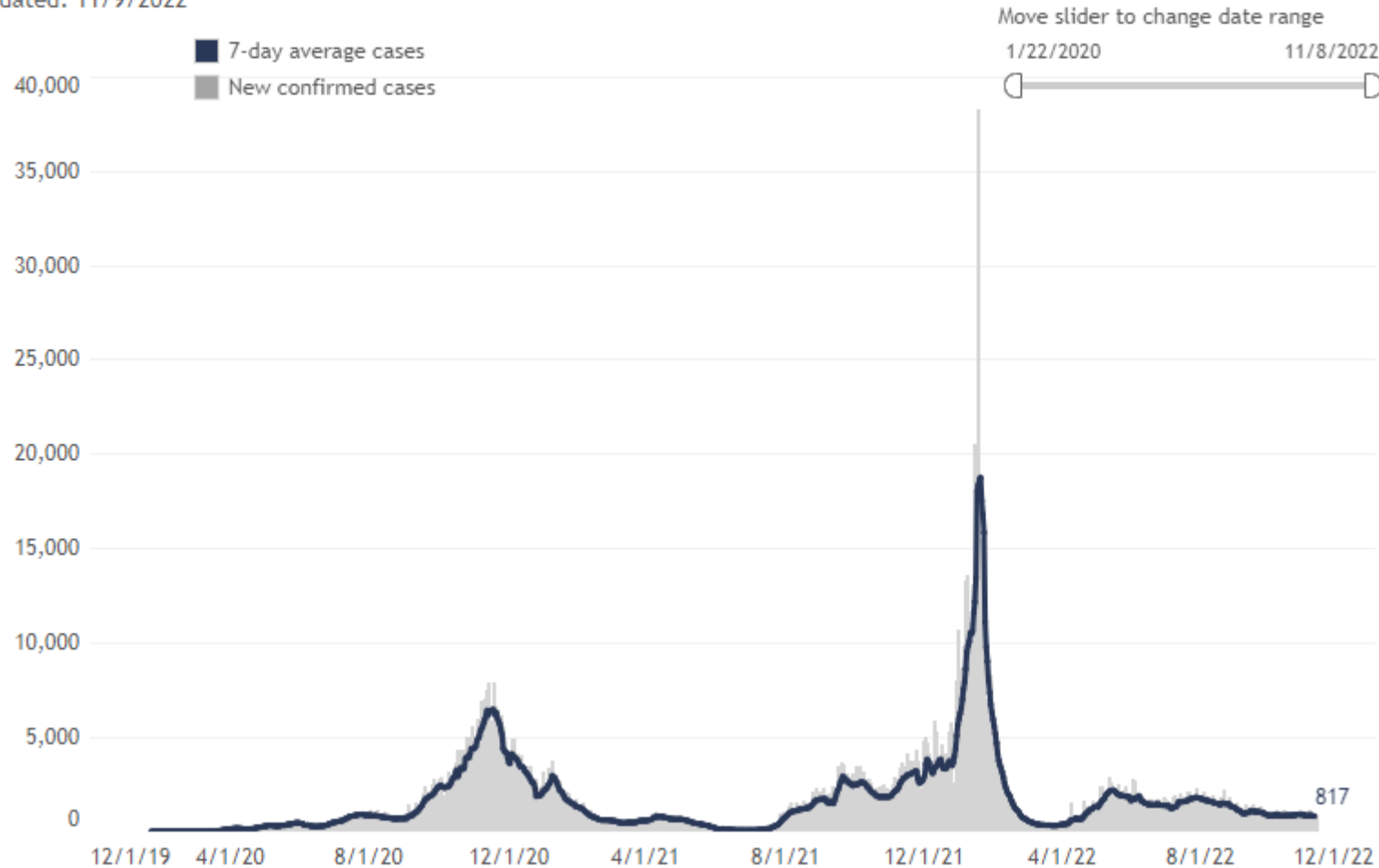

New confirmed COVID-19 cases by date confirmed, and 7-day average

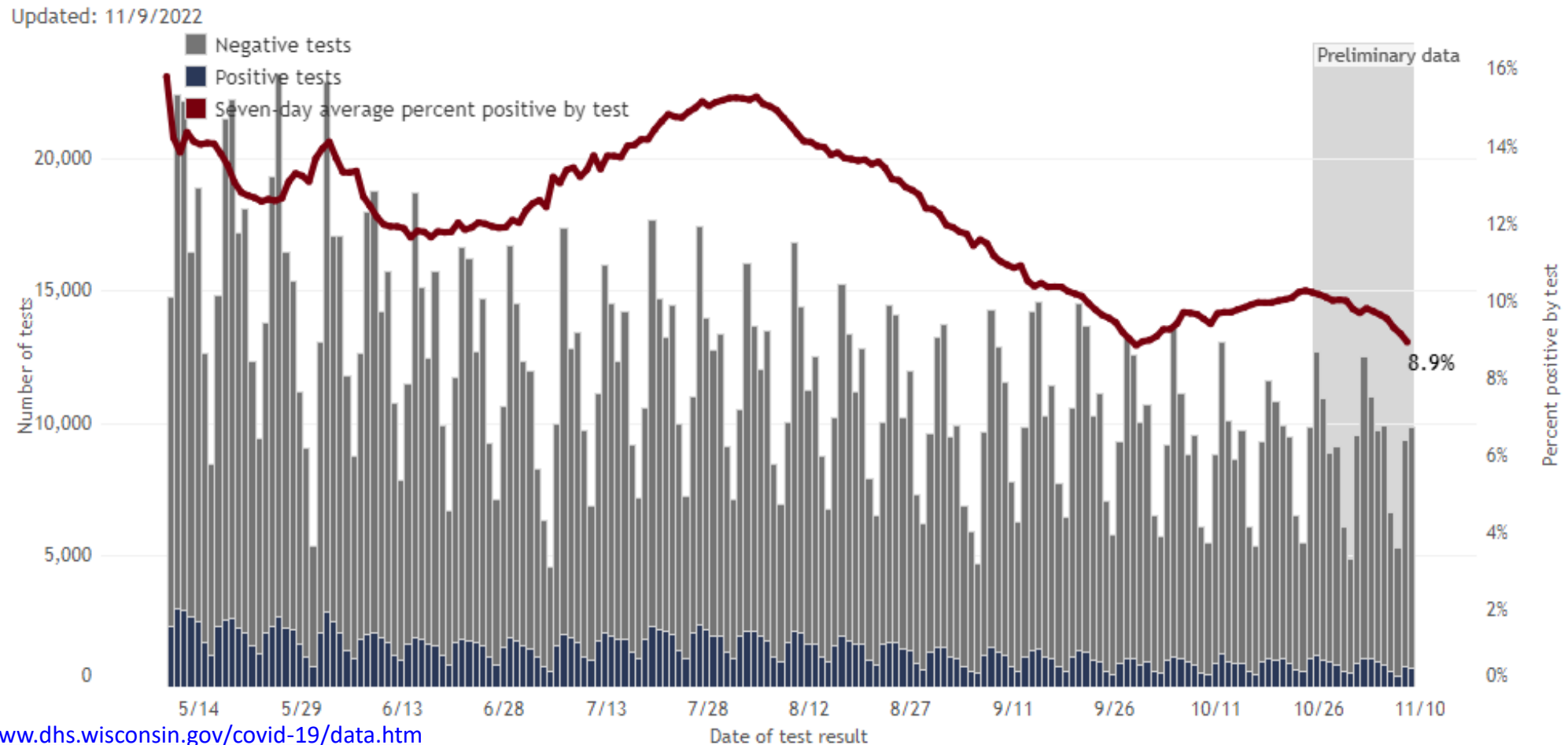

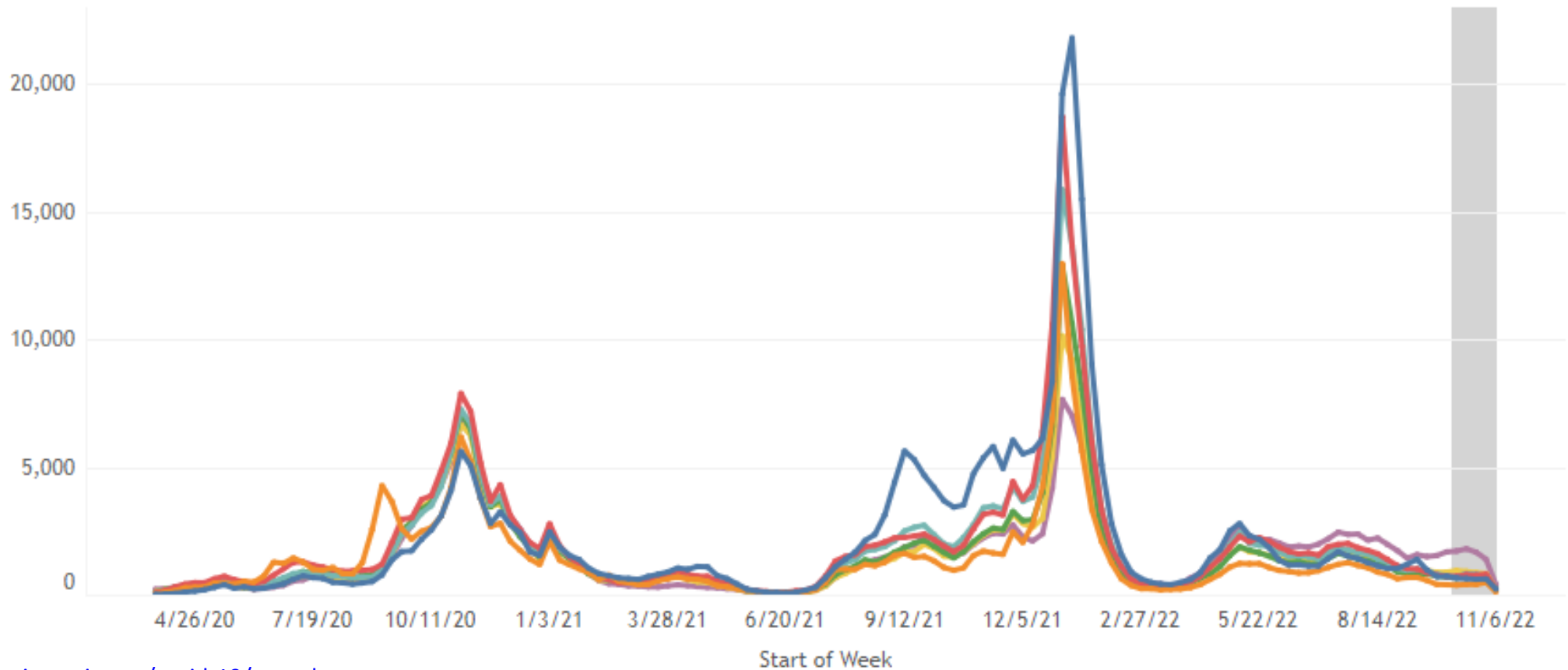

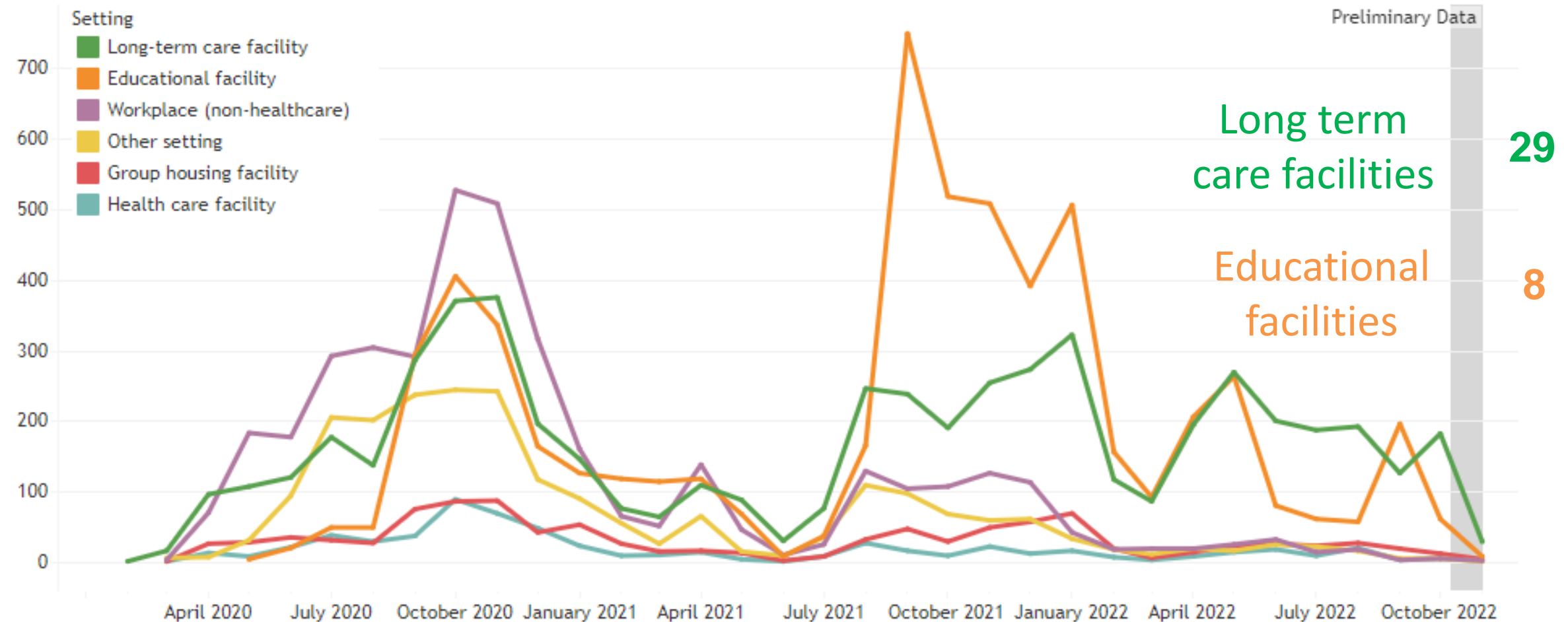

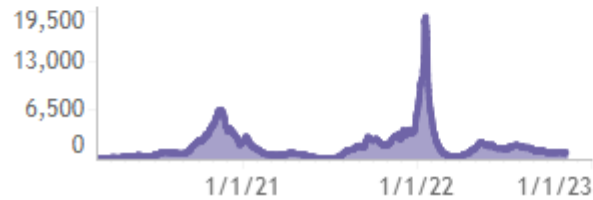

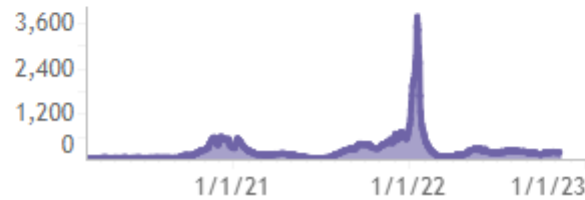
New Confirmed Cases

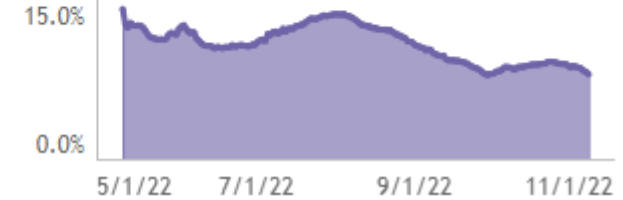
New Probable Cases

(7-day average)

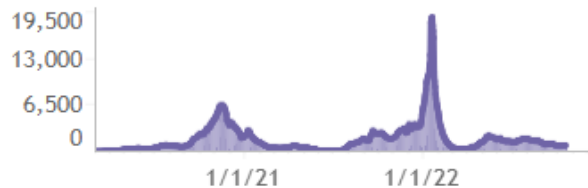

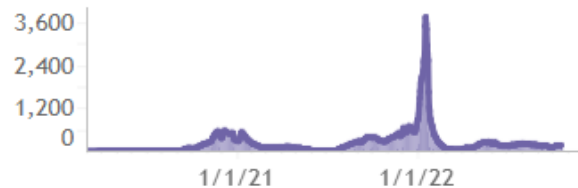
New Confirmed Cases

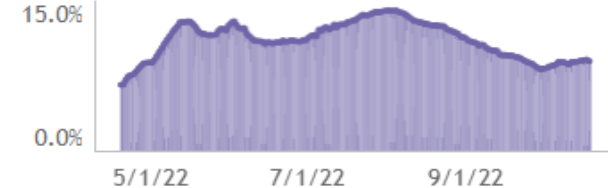
New Probable Cases

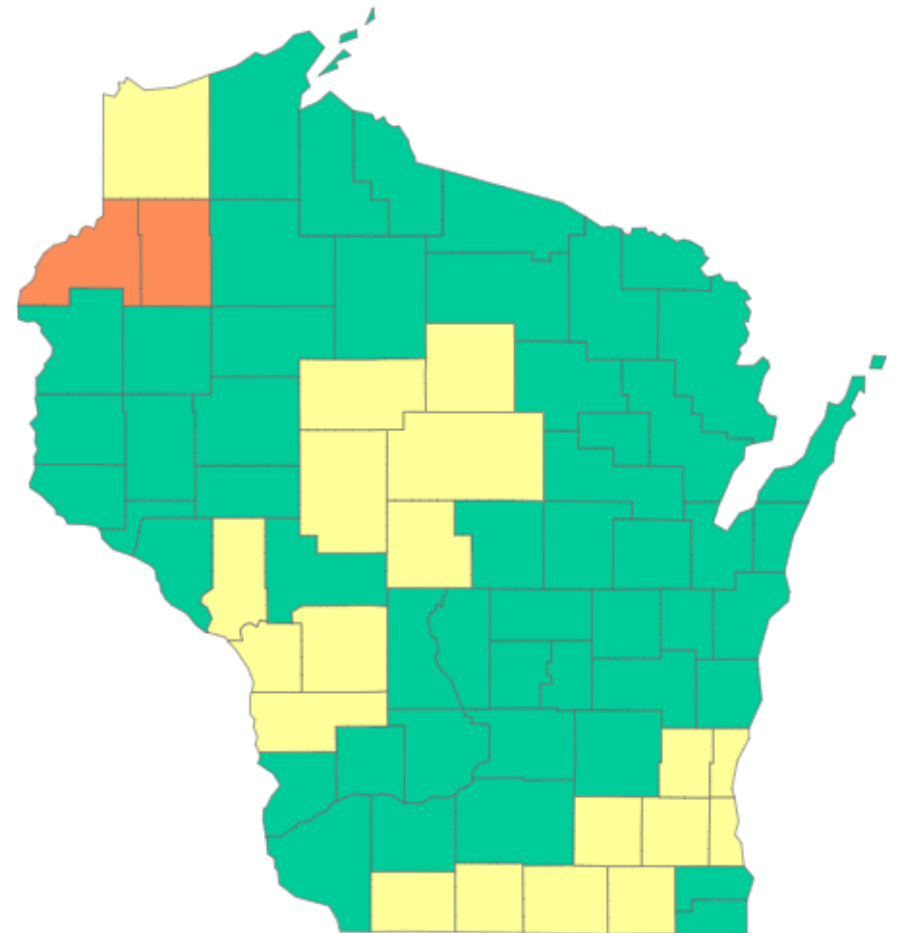

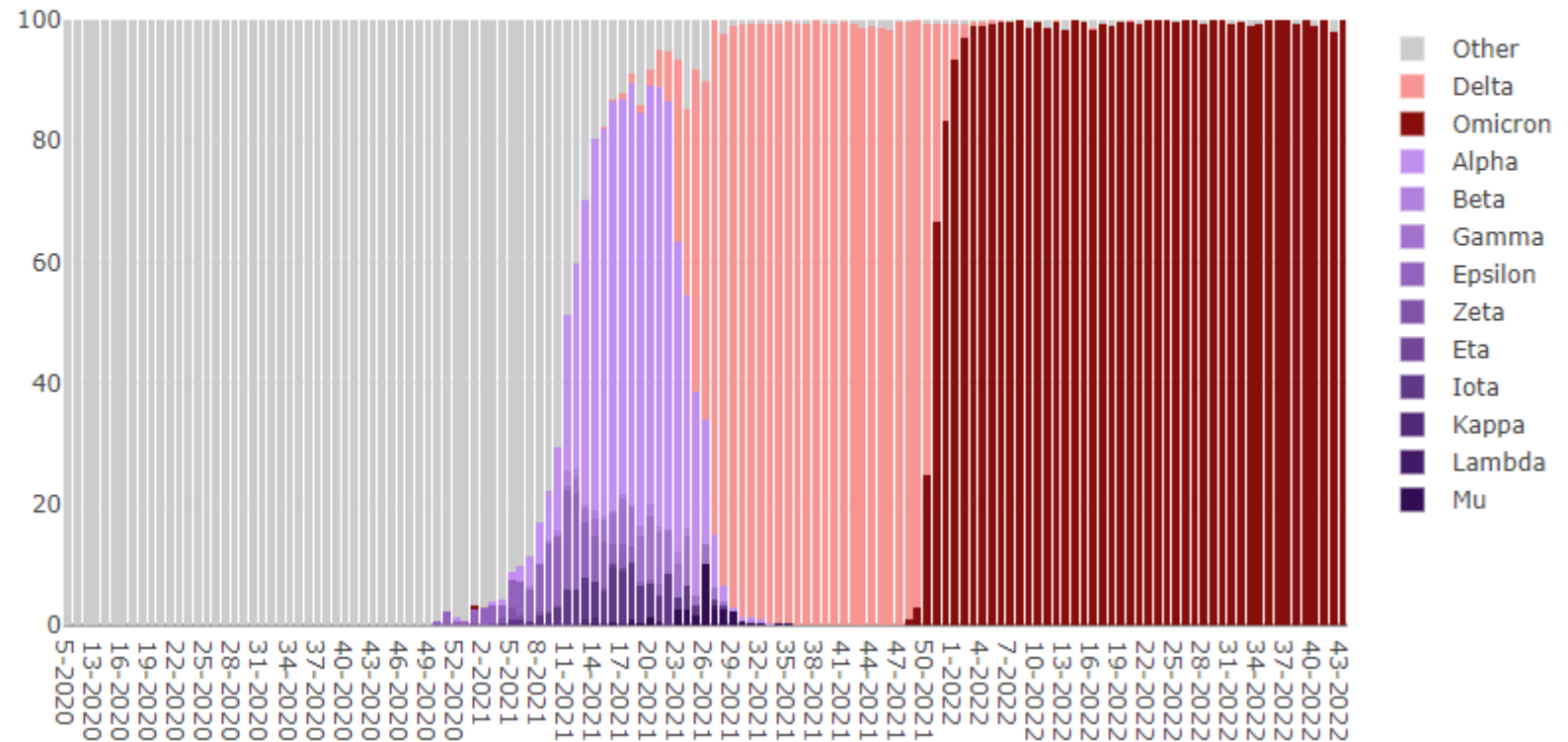

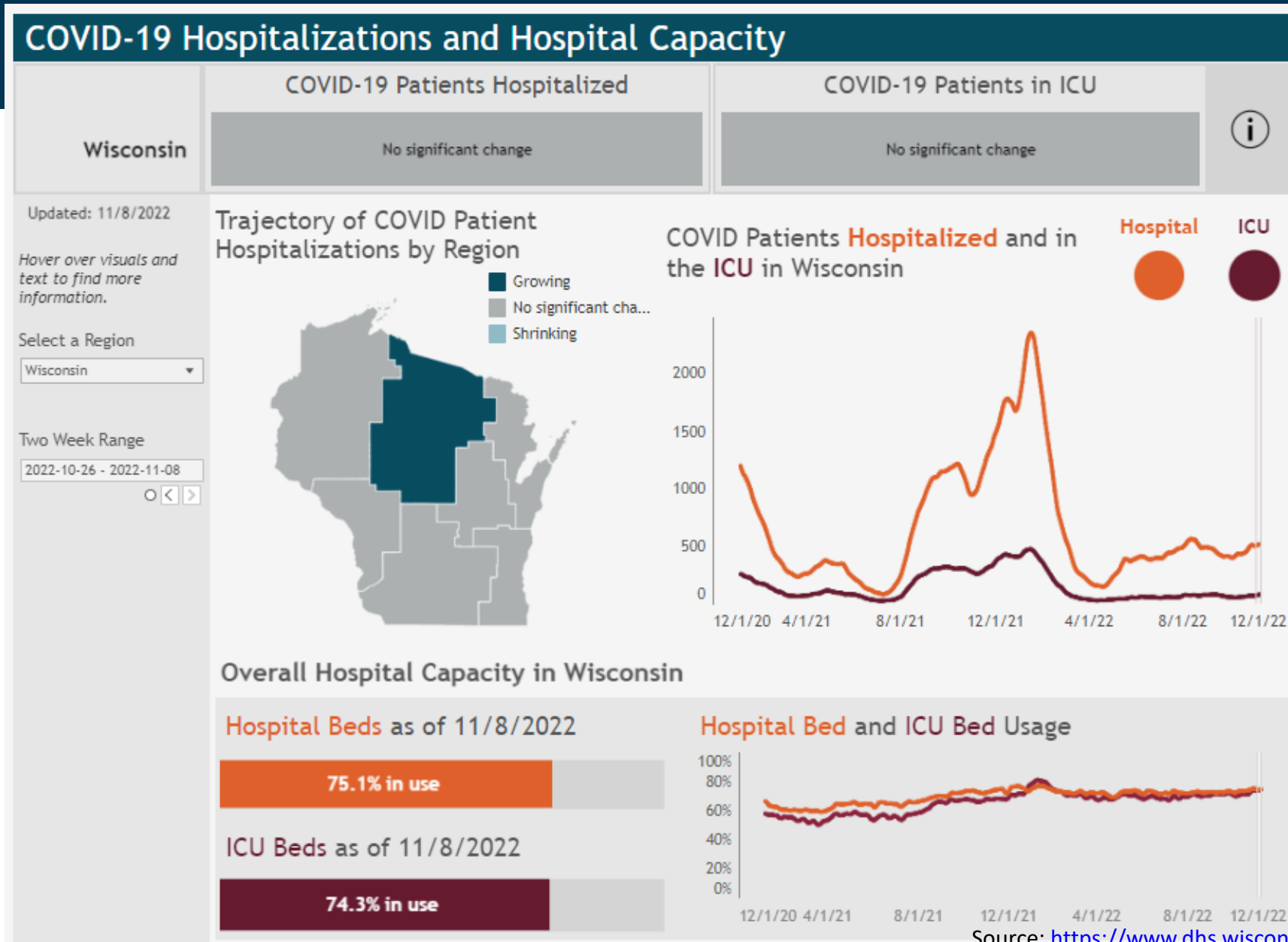

Free COVID-19 Treatment Telehealth service

- **DHS Launches Free Telehealth Service for COVID-19 Treatment**
 - Anyone 18 and older who tests positive for COVID-19 can have a telehealth consultation with a health care clinician within 5-30 minutes.
 - Insurance is not required.
 - The COVID-19 Treatment Telehealth service - available statewide, accessible through internet and telephone, and consultations are available in multiple languages.
 - Consultations - available seven days a week from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m.
 - Service is not for medical emergencies or for treatments other than COVID-19.

Vaccine Updates

- Everyone 5 years and older needs an updated (**bivalent**) booster dose to stay up to date with COVID-19 vaccines.



- **Thanksgiving Holiday Ordering and Delivery Cadence**
 - No COVID-19 vaccine will be delivered from Wednesday, November 23, to Sunday, November 27.
 - Orders placed between 8:00 a.m. on Friday, November 18, and 8:00 a.m. on Wednesday, November 23, will be delivered the week of November 28.
 - Deliveries will resume on Monday, November 28.
 - Please plan to order early prior to the holiday week.

Respiratory season usually begins in October and ends in April

1. The 2022-2023 respiratory season may be severe, especially for young children.
2. This is the first season where COVID, Flu and RSV will all be circulating at the same time.
3. Hospitalization due to non-COVID respiratory diseases are increasing and expected to continue to increase.
4. Vaccination against COVID and Flu are essential to help slow the spread of these viruses.
