

# **Prenatal Care Coordination**

Prenatal Care Coordination (PNCC) is a Wisconsin Medicaid and BadgerCare Plus benefit. Prenatal Care Coordination can help you get support and services while you are pregnant and right after your baby is born. This help is **free**.

# How can Prenatal Care Coordination help?

Pregnancy can be a busy time with many needs. Through Prenatal Care Coordination, you can choose a care coordinator who will:

- Help you get the support and services you need.
- Respect your choices and ideas.
- Meet with you at a time and place that you choose.
- Learn about your current health, strengths, and needs.

# What help can I get through Prenatal Care Coordination?

Care coordinators can:



Give **one-on-one support** to help you understand and deal with the challenges of pregnancy.



Set up needed health care appointments for you.



**Share information** with you about helpful services in your community including FoodShare, housing, and transportation.



Provide **information** on how to keep you and your baby healthy during and after pregnancy.



**Talk** with you about your prenatal care coordination services and **answer any questions** you may have.



Help you **find a health care provider** to care for you and your baby after your baby is born.

Reminder: These services are free.

## What questions can I ask my care coordinator?

You can ask your care coordinator anything about your pregnancy! You may have questions like these:

- What health visits are needed and covered?
- How often should I go to the doctor?
- How will I get to the doctor?
- What are signs of labor?
- What will my baby need after they are born?

A care coordinator can help answer these and other questions.

### **Protect Your Health Information**

**Do not give out your Medicaid ID number** (the 10-digit number on your ForwardHealth card) until you have chosen the right care coordinator for you.
