

# Sexually Transmitted Infections in Wisconsin, 2022

People 20-24 years of age



#### Wisconsin Sexually Transmitted Infections (STI) Surveillance Report 2022 in Person 20 – 24 Years of Age

Overall, reported cases of sexually transmitted infections (chlamydia, gonorrhea, and syphilis) among aged 20-24 **decreased 9%** in 2022 (13,324 cases in 2021 to 12,131 cases in 2022). Reported cases of gonorrhea among people aged 20-24 **decreased by 11%** (2,730 cases in 2021 to 2,442 cases in 2022), similarly reported cases of chlamydia among people aged 20-24 **decreased by 9%** (10,354 cases in 2021 to 9,429 cases in 2022). Unlike chlamydia and gonorrhea, the reported cases of syphilis (all stages) among people aged 20-24 also **increased by 9%** in in 2022 (239 cases in 2021 and 260 cases in 2022).






#### FIGURE 1.

#### **Key Points:**



Sexually Transmitted Infections are widespread, impacting people of all racial and ethnic groups, gender, and ages in Wisconsin.



Rates of syphilis (all stages) increased in 2022 among young adults in Wisconsin.



The most vulnerable populations include men and women between ages 20-35.

#### **Technical Notes**

- 1. This report is compiled by the Wisconsin STI Unit and are based on STI case surveillance data collected by the Wisconsin Division of Public Health (DPH). In Wisconsin, state statutes require both laboratories and health care providers to report cases of chlamydia, gonorrhea, syphilis, chancroid, and pelvic inflammatory disease to local health departments. STI case surveillance data is automatically sent to the Wisconsin STI Unit via WEDSS (Wisconsin Electronic Disease Surveillance System).
- 2. This report includes cases diagnosed within the specified period. Additional cases diagnosed within the specified period may continue to be reported. Thus, this report should be considered provisional, and it supersedes all previous reports.
- 3. Reporting of STI cases can be incomplete. Reporting rates can vary by disease, geographic region, and demographic groups. At any time, reported STI cases represent only part of the total number of diagnosed cases, therefore STI surveillance data likely underestimates total STI morbidity.
- 4. Rate is calculated based on the population data available on the WISH (Wisconsin Interactive Statistics on Health) system website. In these reports, rates presented are cases per 100,000 population (2020). Rates are not calculated for categories with small numbers of cases. See each report for the rate calculation threshold.
- 5. In this report, cases are allocated to the derived county at the time of diagnosis. Cases from federal, state, or certain private institutions are included, and geographic region for these cases are assigned as institution.
- 6. Cases residing outside Wisconsin are not included in this report.
- 6. All races are non-Hispanic ethnicity. Under the category race, Asian includes Asian Pacific Islander and American Indian Alaska Native is named as Native American.
- 7. Rates based on five case counts or less are not shown and rates based on case counts less than 12 are marked as statistically unreliable.
