Despite the interruption of delivery of STI testing services due to the Covid – 19 pandemic, overall STI cases reported in Northeastern region increased 8.6% in 2021. The most significant change observed in 2021 was a **74% increase in Syphilis** cases reported. In 2021, gonorrhea cases increased by 11% and chlamydia cases increased by 7%.


STIs in Northeastern region continue to rise.

Sexually Transmitted Infections are widespread, impacting people of all races, ethnicities, gender, ages.



Rates of chlamydia, Gonorrhea, and syphilis increased in 2021. The syphilis has the highest (71%) increase among the three STIs.



The most vulnerable populations include men and women between ages 20-35.

Technical Notes

1. This report is compiled by the Wisconsin STI Unit and are based on STI case surveillance data collected by the Wisconsin Division of Public Health (DPH). In Wisconsin, state statutes require both laboratories and health care providers to report cases of chlamydia, gonorrhea, syphilis, chancroid, and pelvic inflammatory disease to local health departments. STI case surveillance data is automatically sent to the Wisconsin STI Unit via WEDSS (Wisconsin Electronic Disease Surveillance System).

2. This report includes cases diagnosed within the specified period. Additional cases diagnosed within the specified period may continue to be reported. Thus, this report should be considered provisional, and it supersedes all previous reports.

3. Reporting of STI cases can be incomplete. Reporting rates can be varied by disease, geographic region, and demographic groups. At any time, reported STI cases represent only part of the total number of diagnosed cases, therefore STI surveillance data likely underestimates total STI morbidity.

4. Rate is calculated based on the population data available on WISH (Wisconsin Interactive Statistics on Health) system website. In these reports, rates presented are cases per 100,000 population (2020). Rates are not calculated for categories with small numbers of cases. See each report for the rate calculation threshold.

5. In this report, cases are allocated to the derived county at the time of diagnosis. Cases from federal, state, or certain private institutions are not included in the regional report but is included in the statewide report and geographic region for these cases are assigned as institution.

6. Cases residing outside Wisconsin are not included in this report.

7. All races are non-Hispanic ethnicity. Under the category race, Asian includes Asian Pacific Islander and American Indian Alaska Native is named as Native American.

8. Rates based on five case counts or less are not shown and rates based on case counts less than 12 are marked as statistically unreliable.

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
