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Wisconsin Sexually Transmitted Infections (STI) Surveillance Report Northeastern Region – 2022

Overall, reported cases of sexually transmitted infections (chlamydia, gonorrhea, and syphilis) in the northeastern region **decreased by 12%** in 2022 compared to 2021 (5,665 cases in 2021 to 5,011 cases in 2022). Reported cases gonorrhea **decreased by 28%** in the same time period (1,105 cases in 2021 to 792 cases in 2022). Likewise, reported cases of chlamydia **decreased by 8%** in 2022 compared to 2021 (4,410 cases in 2021 to 4,043 cases in 2022).

Unlike chlamydia and gonorrhea cases, the number of reported syphilis cases **increased by 17%** in 2022 compared to 2021 (150 cases in 2021 to 176 in 2022).

Trend of reported cases of STI in the northeastern region, 2018 - 2022




Technical Notes

1. This report is compiled by the Wisconsin STI Unit and are based on STI case surveillance data collected by the Wisconsin Division of Public Health (DPH). In Wisconsin, state statutes require both laboratories and health care providers to report cases of chlamydia, gonorrhea, syphilis, chancroid, and pelvic inflammatory disease to local health departments. STI case surveillance data is automatically sent to the Wisconsin STI Unit via WEDSS (Wisconsin Electronic Disease Surveillance System).

2. This report includes cases diagnosed within the specified period. Additional cases diagnosed within the specified period may continue to be reported. Thus, this report should be considered provisional, and it supersedes all previous reports.

3. Reporting of STI cases can be incomplete. Reporting rates can be varied by disease, geographic region, and demographic groups. At any time, reported STI cases represent only part of the total number of diagnosed cases, therefore STI surveillance data likely underestimates total STI morbidity.

4. Rate is calculated based on the population data available on WISH (Wisconsin Interactive Statistics on Health) system website. In these reports, rates presented are cases per 100,000 population (2020). Rates are not calculated for categories with small numbers of cases. See each report for the rate calculation threshold.

5. In this report, cases are allocated to the derived county at the time of diagnosis. Cases from federal, state, or certain private institutions are not included in the regional report but is included in the statewide report and geographic region for these cases are assigned as institution.

6. Cases residing outside Wisconsin are not included in this report.

7. All races are non-Hispanic ethnicity. Under the category race, Asian includes Asian Pacific Islander and American Indian Alaska Native is named as Native American.

8. Rates based on five case counts or less are not shown and rates based on case counts less than 12 are marked as statistically unreliable.

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
