Zika disease is caused by a virus 80% of infected people exhibit <u>NO</u> symptoms Zika can be spread from person to person through sex

Zika is spread by two types of mosquitoes not regularly found in Wisconsin Zika can cause serious birth defects if a pregnant woman becomes infected Pregnant women and those who wish to get pregnant in the next 8 weeks should not travel to Zika-affected areas

There is no vaccine to prevent or medication to treat Zika

Symptoms can include fever, rash, joint pain, and red eyes Pregnant women and ill individuals with potential exposure to Zika should see their provider
