

UPDATED: HPV Vaccination Recommendations

NEW ACIP Guidelines for Vaccinating Against Human Papillomavirus (HPV):

2 doses

(at least 6 months apart)



Boys and girls ages 9-14

3 doses



● People ages 15-26

AND/OR

● Immunocompromised people ages 9-26

» The new guidance recommends boys and girls ages 9-14 years receive two doses of the vaccine (at least six months apart) instead of the three doses previously recommended.

- Three doses are still recommended for anyone who starts the vaccination series between ages 15-26 years and/or for those ages 9-26 who are immunocompromised.
- Individuals ages 15-26 years who did not get two doses of the vaccine at least six months apart will still need a third dose.

» The vaccination is routinely recommended for boys and girls at age 9, and through age 26 for catch-up immunizations.
