

New: SHIP Counselor Certification Course

- Volunteers and other SHIP counselors can register as "SHIP Counselors (Non-benefit specialist)" to access the SHIP Counselor Certification Training in the Learning Management System, which includes links to SHIP Technical Assistance (TA) Center courses.
- Benefit specialist Medicare courses will be updated by early 2022.

SHIP Certification

Process and timeline

New: Certification Process

SHIP counselors must be certified to provide one-on-one counseling and outreach.

- Basic level: new-to-Medicare appointments,
 Open Enrollment Period plan comparisons
- Advanced level (benefit specialists): complex topics including Medicaid and appeals
- Transition period for existing counselors through June 2022

Action Item for Counselors

Current benefit specialists and other SHIP counselors must take the exam on the SHIP Technical Assistance (TA) Center website by 06/30/2022.

- Open book
- No time limit
- 90% to pass
- Printable certificate
- One-and-done



Unique ID

Benefits and process

Review: What is a Unique ID?

The Unique ID is an identifier of eligible SHIP counselors that provides direct access to a variety of partners for assistance in resolving Medicare issues on a beneficiary's behalf, including:

- Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS).
- Participating Medicare plans.
- Benefits Coordination & Recovery Center (BCRC).
- Limited Income Newly Eligible Transition (LINET).

New: Stricter Eligibility for the Unique ID

The Administration for Community Living (ACL) now requires annual completion of the privacy training and confidentiality agreement.

Benefit specialists must:

- Upload the <u>Confidentiality Agreement</u> to the <u>learning management system</u> in January.
- Pass the Advanced SHIP Certification Exam in the SHIP TA Center by June 30, 2022.
