What do I need to know?

During the COVID-19 pandemic, a federal program let us give you extra FoodShare benefits in addition to your regular amount. Now, due to recent changes to federal law, the extra amounts are ending. February 2023 is the last scheduled month you will get extra benefits. Qualifying families will continue to get their regular FoodShare amounts.
