

Statewide Performance Improvement Indicators

The intent of this document is to list the required and recommended performance improvement (PI) indicators for level III and level IV trauma care facilities in the State of Wisconsin. These indicators can be found in <u>Wis. Admin. Code ch. DHS 118</u>, <u>Appendix A</u>. Please note, PI indicators that are designated as "recommended" by the State of Wisconsin may be required through a different credentialing body, such as the Joint Commission.
