Stockbox: The Senior Commodity Supplemental Food Program



Stockbox provides food

Receive a monthly package of shelf stable foods providing about a weeks' worth of groceries that may include:

- Protein: canned poultry, fish, beans, or peanut butter.
- Grains: pasta, rice, cereal, or oats.
- Fruit: canned fruits and 100% fruit juice.

Stockbox serves Wisconsin seniors,

- Age 60 or older.
- Living in Wisconsin.
- Within monthly income requirements.

Stockbox is easy to get

- You may appoint a caregiver, friend, or family to pick up your food package.
- You can still receive FoodShare, Senior Farmers Market checks, TEFAP, and any additional food pantry foods.
- Stockbox is available at senior centers, senior housing, community buildings, churches, and food pantries in some WI counties.
