7.2% of Wisconsinites were food insecure in 2021.



618,818 Wisconsin households were served by the TEFAP network.

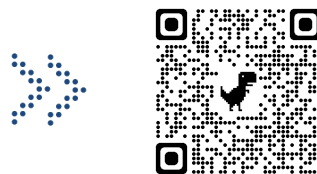


21.8 million pounds of food were distributed through TEFAP.
