List of Repairs Developed

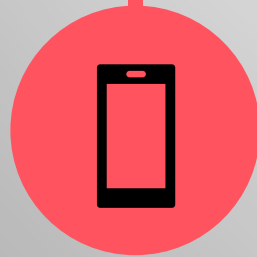


The service provider contacts you to schedule the repairs, and the contractor completes the repairs.

Repairs Completed

Home Visit Scheduled

If your landlord agrees, the service provider contacts you to schedule a home visit to do a detailed assessment.



Repairs Approved

The service provider contacts your landlord to get approval for the repairs. If approved, they find a contractor to work on the repairs.
