The Path to Becoming a Dental Therapist

Prerequisites:

- Prerequisites vary across dental therapy programs and must be reviewed before applying.
- Individuals must be graduates from an accredited dental hygiene program and hold a Wisconsin dental hygiene license to apply for the only dental therapy program in the state.

Dental therapy programs:

In Wisconsin, <u>Northcentral Technical College</u> has an accredited dental therapy program that offers an associate degree in dental therapy.

Licensing:

- Graduates must apply for a Wisconsin dental therapy license upon graduating from an accredited dental therapy program.
- People who graduate (or graduated) from an out-of-state dental therapy program may also apply for a Wisconsin dental therapy license.
