

# Apply for FoodShare, Medicaid, and More



Do you need help getting health insurance? Are you unsure how you will pay for your groceries this month? Do you need help paying for child care costs while you go to school, work, or a work training program? Do you need help developing your skills or finding a job?

Wisconsin has state benefits to help with these situations and more. Your qualification process starts by filling out an application so we can understand your household and finances.

## Choose your method

Apply for benefits whatever way is easiest for you.

- **Online:** Go to [access.wi.gov](https://access.wi.gov) to create an account and log in.
- **By phone or in person:** Contact your local agency. We recommend calling them ahead of time to make an appointment. Find your agency at [dhs.wi.gov/im-agency](https://dhs.wi.gov/im-agency).
- **By mail or fax:** Get a paper application from your agency or go to [dhs.wi.gov/forwardhealth/apply.htm](https://dhs.wi.gov/forwardhealth/apply.htm) to download and print a copy.



Make sure you have information ready to enter for each person who's applying.

- Date of birth
- Address, email, and phone
- Social Security number
- U.S. citizenship or immigration status
- Marital status
- Number of people in your household
- Job details
- Income and expenses
