Members of BadgerCare Plus and other Wisconsin Medicaid programs now have access to more treatment for substance use and mental health disorders. Intensive outpatient (IOP) treatment is a new covered level of care that can help you build a healthier life. You can manage your other commitments (like family, work, or school) while getting the comprehensive treatment you need.

What you need to know

- A typical IOP schedule is three sessions per week of three hours each. Sessions include both individual and group therapy.
- You'll learn coping skills you can practice in your daily life.
- You'll also build a supportive community with others who can relate to what you're going through.

How to get IOP treatment

- Talk to your doctor if you need help.
- If you don't have a primary care doctor, contact your HMO.
