DHS Requests 10-Year SeniorCare Waiver Extension

The Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) is requesting a 10-year renewal of its section 1115 demonstration project for the SeniorCare Prescription Drug Assistance Program to continue the program through December 31, 2028. SeniorCare, Wisconsin's prescription drug assistance program for Wisconsin residents who are 65 years of age or older, is designed to help seniors with their prescription drug costs.

DHS held public hearings around the state earlier this month to seek input on the SeniorCare waiver renewal application. However, written comments are still being accepted through June 7.
